Our wonderful workers installed tiles on the cement floors we have. They built in cabinets for food and kitchen storage. We were also blessed with a new refrigerator and a new washer/dryer combination. This is the first time that we have been able to have a refrigerator and a washer and dryer for the Children's home.

Our house parents love the children, so being able to spend time with each child in their development is wonderful. In the past they had to do grocery shopping daily for the food, because we did not have the refrigeration system to keep foods fresh for the children.
